<b>Practice Description:</b>	Diverse and Rural clinic practice, on-call obligations, air or road travel to other smaller communities within the Dehcho Region, nursing home/elders care home.
<b>Staff Description:</b>	The Fort Simpson Health Centre has a full complement staff consisting of; 1 full time Nurse Administrator; 1 Community Nurse Practitioner; 5 Community Health Nurses; Entry Level Community Health Nurse; Health Promotion Officer; Community Health Representative; Medical Travel Officer; Clerical Aide; Record Management Clerk; and Clerk Interpreter.
<b>Obstetrics required:</b>	No
<b>Call Arrangements:</b>	On-call obligation evening and/or weekends depending on the number of physicians on-site. Community Health Nurses are first and second on-call.
<b>Qualifications (Required/Preferred):</b>	Must be eligible to obtain NWT Medical License.
<b>Compensation:</b>	The standardized physician contract features; guaranteed work week; annual recruitment and retention bonuses; northern allowances; professional fees and education material payments; CMPA; competitive base salary; continuing medical education; on-call services; call-back, generous vacation, special and sick leave; maternity benefits; relocation allowance; group health benefits; defined pension plan contributions.
<b>Additional:</b>	<p>The Fort Simpson Health Center which is a Medical Clinic that also includes Health Services, 18-bed Elders Care Home (2 beds are for respite and/or palliative care), Coordinated Home Care, and Health Promotion. The Northwest Territories Health and Social Services Authority - Dehcho Region, in Fort Simpson is the Regional Center that serves a total of 9 Dehcho communities: Fort Liard (2011 Census pop.536), Fort Providence (pop.734), Fort Simpson (pop.1238), Hay River Reserve (pop.292), Jean Marie River (pop.64), Kakisa Lake (pop.45), Nahanni Butte (pop.102), Trout Lake (pop.92), and Wrigley (pop.133).
