The IRH is an accredited teaching hospital (affiliated with the University of British Columbia), teaching Canadian as well as international students and residents.

Call Arrangements:	Our backup is legendary: help is only a phone call and two minutes away.
Qualifications (Required/Preferred):	Must be eligible to obtain NWT Medical License.
Compensation:	The standard physician contract features a guaranteed 40 hour work week, overtime pay, annual retention bonuses, CME allowance, relocation assistance, enhanced benefit plan and no overhead. Part time work is negotiable.
Additional:	The setting is spectacular – the world’s 10 th largest river Delta, the dancing Aurora Borealis on fall and winter nights and 24-hour sunlight three months of the year. Politically, geographically, recreationally and socially, it is an experience unmatched anywhere else in Canada.
